Resolution 04-05-10-03 A Resolution to Authorize Reducing Number of Election Officials for the Village of Fontana on Geneva Lake Polling Place

Whereas, the Village Board has the authority pursuant to Chapter 7.32 of the Wisconsin State Statutes, which allows a municipal governing body to reduce the required number of election officials at a polling place from 7 to no less than 3; and

Whereas, the Village Board has determined that it would be advantageous to the Village to have only as many election officials on duty as are needed for a given election.

Now Therefore, Be it Resolved by the Village Board of the Village of Fontana on Geneva Lake, Walworth County, Wisconsin, by this resolution, adopted by a majority of the Village Board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, resolves and declares as follows:

There shall be a minimum of 3 election officials on duty at every election. At the discretion of the village clerk, the requisite number of election officials may be increased for any election; however, the number of election officials working at a given election shall always be an odd number.
