Final Minutes

Park Commission Monthly Meeting

Wednesday, May 20, 2026, at 5:00 pm

The Park Commission meeting was called to order by Chairman Trustee Scott Vilona on Wednesday, May 20, 2026, at 5:02 pm at the Fontana Village Hall.

Commissioners Present: Trustee Chair Scott Vilona, Commissioner Robin Nuzzo, Commissioner Susan Olson, and Commissioner Sarah Lobdell.

Commissioners Absent: Commissioner Mary Green, Commissioner Zina O'Callaghan, and Commissioner Stan Livingston.

Also Present: Village Administrator Theresa Loomer, Public Works Director Drew Perepell, and Village Clerk Kim Buchanan.

Approval of the minutes

Commissioner Lobdell moved to approve the March 18, 2026 minutes. Commissioner Nuzzo seconded and the motion passed unanimously.

General Business

Treasurer's Report

Treasurer Baumann provided the Commission with a budget summary and year-to-date revenue and expenditure information.

Public Works Report

Director Perepell stated that the playground mulch has been installed, and bathrooms and the beach are ready for the season. He has reached out to Roy Diblik of Northwind Perennials regarding moving the median plantings but has not been able to connect with him. The proposed area to move them has no sprinklers so native plants would be the best. The plants would need to be watered the first year but then should be okay after that.

Old Business

Discussion or Action on Vision Quest Coaching Park application from Greg Harrison for the Reid Park pavilion– 8/22/26 & 8/29/26 from 8am – 4pm each day – tabled from 3/18/26

Discussion took place regarding what kind of event this is. Administrator Loomer has spoken with the applicant and was told that it was corporate outing and team building event. The pavilion would be a gathering point, and they were intending to walk the lake path. Commissioner Nuzzo moved to approve the permit application for Vision Quest Coaching Park application from Greg Harrison for the Reid Park pavilion– 8/22/26 & 8/29/26 from 8am – 4pm each day. Commissioner Lobdell seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

New Business

Discussion or Action on Big Foot High School Cross Country Invite on 9/24/26 7am to 7pm

Commissioner Lobdell moved to recommend approval to the Village Board the permit application for the Big Foot High School Cross Country Invite on 9/24/26 7am to 7pm. Commissioner Olson seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

Update on Reid Park Pavilion resurfacing project

The Reid Park Pavilion floor is in rough shape. The Village Board has approved a contract with Stateline Surface Solutions for \$24,625. The Big Foot Lions Club will cover half the cost of the project. The pavilion will be closed for approximately one week for the project to be completed. It was stated that the Tourism budget should cover the balance of the costs.

Replace Puck lights in concrete in Reid Park bathrooms and Beach

Several of the puck lights set in the concrete need to be replaced. The current style of light has been discontinued. DPW Director Perepell has been researching lights to fit the current housings and found something similar for \$190 per fixture. There are approximately two dozen puck lights, and the cost would be about \$4,400. He also stated that an alternate solution would be to get rid of the puck lights and add more sconces. The puck lights do look nice so he will continue to look for replacements for them. This cost would also be one for Tourism to cover. Commissioner Nuzzo moved to replace one light and see how it goes before purchasing the balance of the lights that need to be replaced. Commissioner Lobdell seconded that motion. Motion passed unanimously.

Commissioner Olson moved to adjourn at 5:16 pm. Commissioner Lobdell seconded and the Motion carried without a negative vote.
