

ORDINANCE NO. 09-12-16-01

**AN ORDINANCE REPEALING AND RECREATING SECTION 42-1.
OFFENSES AGAINST STATE LAW AS SUBJECT TO FORFEITURE**

The Village Board of the Village of Fontana-on-Geneva Lake, Walworth County, Wisconsin do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1.

Section 42-1 shall be repealed and recreated to read as follows:

Sec. 42-1. Offenses against state laws subject to forfeiture.

The following statutes defining offenses against the peace and good order of the state are adopted by reference in this section to define offenses against the peace and good order of the Village, provided that the penalty for commission of such offenses shall be limited to a forfeiture imposed under the general penalty provisions. Any future amendments, revisions or modifications of the statutes incorporated in this section by reference are intended to be made part of this chapter.
