# FONTANA BOULEVARD TREE REPLACEMENT PROGRAM

Cost of the program is \$500 per tree (see the list below). This includes the cost for purchasing, planting, maintaining the tree (fertilizing, pruning, mulching, etc.). After the tree is planted, the contact person will receive notification. Trees ordered from April 1 through September 15 will be planted in the fall. Trees ordered September 16 through March 31 will be planted in the spring. All trees will be located along Fontana Boulevard.
