

Ordinance 01-06-14-01
An Ordinance Amending Sections 2-1(3) and 26-1(b) of the Village of Fontana Municipal Code Regarding the term length of the Municipal Court judge.

The Board of Trustees for the Village of Fontana on Geneva Lake, Walworth County, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

Section 1. Section 2-1(3) shall be amended to read as follows:

Sec. 2-1. **Elected officials.**

The elected officials of the village shall be as follows:

	Official	When Elected	Term (years)
(1)	Village president	Odd-numbered years	2
(2)	Six trustees	Three elected in even-numbered years; three elected in odd-numbered years	2
(3)	Municipal judge	Even-numbered years, <u>once every four years commencing in 2012</u>	2 <u>4</u>

Section 2. Section 26-1(b) shall be amended to read as follows:

Sec. 26-1. **Municipal judge.**

(a) *Office created.* Pursuant to § 755.01, Wis. Stats., there is created the office of municipal judge for the village.

(b) *Election; term.* The municipal judge shall be elected at large at the spring election for a term of ~~two~~ four years, or until a successor is elected and qualifies, commencing on May 1 next succeeding his election. Mid-term vacancies in the office of municipal judge shall be filled by special election to be held not less than 55 nor more than 70 days after the order of the board.

Section 3. **Effective Date:** This ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage approval, and publication as required by law.
