

**Ordinance 03-02-15-02**

**An Ordinance Amending Section 74-2 of the Village of Fontana on Geneva Lake Municipal Code Regarding all-terrain vehicles state statutes.**

The Board of Trustees for the Village of Fontana on Geneva Lake, Walworth County, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

**Section 1.** Section 74-2 of the Municipal Code of the Village of Fontana on Geneva Lake is hereby amended as follows:

**Sec. 74-2.** State traffic law adopted.

Except as otherwise specifically provided in this chapter, the statutory provision in chs. 23.33 and 340 to 348, Wis. Stats., describing and defining regulations with respect to vehicles, all-terrain vehicles, utility terrain vehicles, and traffic, exclusive of any provisions relating to penalties to be imposed and exclusive of any regulations for which the statutory penalty is a fine or a term of imprisonment, are adopted and by reference made a part of this section as if fully set forth. Any act required to be performed or prohibited by any statute incorporated in this section by reference and listed in this section is required or prohibited by this section. All adopted state statutes under this chapter shall be applicable to all municipal parking lots and all other municipal properties. In addition, where the terms "street," "highway" or "roadway" are used in these statutes, such terms will also define for purposes of this chapter those areas of any municipal parking lot or municipal property used for vehicular travel and/or parking.
