ORDINANCE NO. 030722-04

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 54-161(d)(5), PARKING LOT FEES, OF THE VILLAGE OF FONTANA ON GENEVA LAKE MUNICIPAL CODE

The Village Board of the Village of Fontana-on-Geneva Lake, Walworth County, Wisconsin do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1.

Section 54-161(d)(5) is hereby amended as follows:

(5) Parking lot fees.

- a. The boat/trailer parking lot No. 4 is open to for general public use, and the fees shall be as determined by the village board and shall be charged daily, including Saturdays, Sundays and holidays from April 15 to October 15 of each year.
 - 1. The use of parking lots Nos. 1, 2 and 3 shall be restricted to vehicles or motorcycles as determined by state license plate designation and shall not include trailers, recreational vehicles, commercial buses or trucks in excess of three-quarter ton. These are pay to park lots, operating daily from 8:00 am to 8:00 pm, April 15 to October 15 of each year. Notwithstanding the pay to park, vehicles with a current resident stieker parking pass displayed clearly on the front lower left driver's side windshield, may be parked in these stalls and those located on Reid Street and on Third Avenue from Reid Street east to the Park House with no additional daily fee. Unless otherwise posted, only one vehicle shall be parked in each stall.
 - 2. For vehicles with trailers, and recreational vehicles per hour, said fee shall be determined by the village board. For commercial buses per hour, said fee shall be determined by the village board. Recreational vehicles, buses, and vehicles with non-boat trailers are also not permitted to park within municipal parking lot 4. Resident and/or employee parking passes do not apply to recreational vehicles, buses, or vehicles with non-boat trailers. Vehicles parked within lot 4 shall remain unoccupied and engine idling is prohibited.
 - 3. Upon payment of such annual fee as may be determined by the board, a resident or employee of a current business on Lake Street or Third Avenue from the corner of Lake Street to Reid Street, the village shall issue an single sticker employee parking pass which shall be clearly visible, attached to the front lower left driver's side front windshield of the motor vehicle. The designated employee sticker parking pass shall only be valid in lot Nos. 2 and 3.
 - 4. No fees for parking in the boat/trailer parking lot shall be imposed on any person who has paid the launch access fees set forth in subsection 4. above, and who possesses a receipt for such payment, or a season pass sticker. No boats are allowed on the trailers for this provision. In addition, all unattached trailers without a vehicle will be towed at the owner's expense.

- 5. Vehicles without a trailer and without an employee or resident parking sticker pass may only use the single spot parking stalls and must have a valid parking lot receipt displayed pay the meter for the current day between the hours of 6:00 8:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m.
 - i. Reserved.
 - ii. Parking-lot tickets shall not be accepted as free access to the beach.
 - iii. Notwithstanding the provisions set forth in subsection (d)(5)a., the following annual fee shall be charged the following for the use of the parking lots; referred to in this subsection:
 - A. For a resident or a property owner of the village not using the village launch facilities, said fee shall be determined by the board.
 - iv. Upon payment of such sums, the village shall issue not more than four stickers per parcel, which shall be applied to the front windshield of the motor vehicle.
- b. Parking lot tickets receipts shall not be accepted as free access to the beach.
- c. Notwithstanding the provisions set forth in subsection (d)(5)a., the following annual fee shall be charged the following for the use of the parking lots; referred to in this subsection:
 - 1. For a resident or a property owner of the village not using the village launch facilities, said fee shall be determined by the board.
 - Reserved.
- d. Upon payment of such sums, the village shall issue not more than four stickers resident parking passes per parcel, which shall be applied to the front lower left driver's side windshield of the motor vehicle.
- e. During special events which include, but shall not be limited to, the Fourth of July and the triathlon, the village may designate any of the metered parking for special event parking. This designation will be accompanied by a special fee as determined by the board, and will be charged by a parking attendant in lieu of the meter charge. This charge shall not apply to Fontana residents who have purchased their annual resident parking pass.
- (6) Boat slip charges. The board may lease the use of a boat slip, and the fee charged shall be as determined by the board.
- (7) Shore station charges. The board may lease the use of a shore station, and the fee charged shall be determined by the board.
- (8) Filing of fees. The fees the board may determine as set forth in subsection (d) shall be reduced to writing and filed in the office of the clerk and open to inspection by members of the public during village hall business hours.
- (9) Municipal service or facility usage.

- a. Anyone who uses or attempts to use a municipal service or facility without first paying the required usage fee shall be subject to the penalty provisions of section 1-
- b. In this section a municipal service or facility requiring a usage fee shall include, but is not limited to the following: municipal boat ramp, municipal park lot No. 4 (boat lot), municipal beach, and any public facilities for which a fee is required in advance.
- Pier regulations.
 - (1) Maintenance of piers. All piers shall be kept and maintained in a clean, attractive and safe condition.
 - (2) Painting of piers. The board may establish uniform requirements as to type and painting of piers abutting public property.
- (f) Buoy regulations.
 - Buoys. Installation of buoys shall not exceed one buoy for each ten feet of shoreline owned or leased by the petitioner for buoy permits, except that the number may be reduced because of bay-type shoreline and application of subsection (f)(2).
 - (2) Buoy placement. Placement of buoys shall be at the discretion of the owners, except that no buoy may be placed closer than 15 feet from a line measured at 90 degrees from the shoreline where it intersects with the property line.
- (g) Reserved.
- (h) All launches shall be paid for during the designated timeframe listed in subsection 54-161(d)(4). In the event the launch is not staffed, the honor box shall be utilized.

SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE

The ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage approval and publication as required by law.
