

ORDINANCE NO. 070824-01

An Ordinance Amending Repealing Section 18-216(b)(1), Amending Section 18-216(e), and Amending Section 18-166(b) of the Municipal Code for the Village of Fontana-on-Geneva Lake

The Village Board of the Village of Fontana-on-Geneva Lake, Walworth County, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1.

Section 18-216(b)(1) of the Municipal Code for the Village of Fontana-on-Geneva Lake is hereby repealed.

SECTION 2.

Section 18-216(e) of the Municipal Code for the Village of Fontana-on-Geneva Lake is hereby amended to read as follows:

(e) *Enclosure required.* Every person owning or occupying land on which there is situated a swimming pool which contains 24 inches or more in depth at any point, shall erect and maintain an adequate enclosure surrounding the pool area sufficient to make such body of water inaccessible to small children. Pools within the scope of this section which are not enclosed with a permanent building shall be completely enclosed by a fence of sufficient strength to prevent access to the pool. Such fence shall not be less than four feet in height and so constructed as not to have voids, holes, or openings larger than four inches in one dimension. Gates or doors shall be kept locked while the pool is not in actual use. This enclosure shall be erected as soon as possible prior to or during construction, and unless special permission is given by the building inspector before water is placed in the pool.

SECTION 3.

Section 18-166(b) of the Municipal Code for the Village of Fontana-on-Geneva Lake is hereby amended to read as follows:

(b) *Materials.* Acceptable materials for constructing fencing include wood, stone, brick, wrought iron, and chain link. No fence may be constructed, in whole or in part, of barbed wire, nor shall any portion of any fence be electrified. Any fence within a front yard, street side yard, or the rear yard of a double frontage lot shall be a minimum 40 percent open, or no more than 60 percent opaque. Solid fences are permitted in interior side yards and rear yards.


EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon and from its passage, approval, and publication as required by law.
