Meeting of the Village of Fontana Police and Fire Commission
Monday, February 10, 2025

The Police and Fire Commission meeting at the Village Hall was called to order by PFC President Joe Haughey at 3:20 p.m.

Commission Members Present: President Haughey, Commissioner Kaminski, and Commissioner Woodbury

General Business

Accept Minutes of November 4, 2024 Meeting

Kaminski/Woodbury 2nd made a Motion to approve the November 4, 2024 meeting minutes for the Police and Fire Commission, and the MOTION carried with no negative vote.

Closed Session

Haughey/Kaminski 2nd made a Motion to go into closed session pursuant to Chapter 19.85(1)(c), for the purpose of “Considering employment, promotion, compensation or performance evaluation data of any public employee over which the governmental body has jurisdiction or exercises responsibility,” specifically Part-Time FF/Paramedic candidate employment recommendation.

Kaminski/Woodbury 2nd made a Motion to adjourn from closed session and go back into open session, and the MOTION carried with no negative vote.

Resume Open Session

Chief Manthy recruited candidate Rhonda Baumann on a “rolling basis” pursuant to sub-sect. 9.4(a) of the PFC Rules & Regs. The Chief submitted a report summarizing the candidate’s past experience, education, and certifications obtained showing that she met all the required qualifications for the part-time FF/Paramedic position. Upon review of the materials presented and based on Chief Manthy’s evaluation of the candidate’s qualifications, the Commissioners unanimously agreed that the candidate was highly qualified to fill the FF/Paramedic position.

Haughey/Kaminski 2nd made a Motion to approve Rhonda Baumann for employment as a Part-Time FF/Paramedic, and the MOTION carried without negative vote.

NOTE: Any offer of employment to the candidate is contingent upon successfully completing physical examination, psychological examination, drug screening, and additional background investigation.
