South Lake Shore Drive Reconstruction

Village of Fontana-on-Geneva Lake

The South Lake Shore Drive project is nearing completion. Remember to **SLOW DOWN IN CONSTRUCTION ZONES** and take extra precautions around construction crews and pedestrians. **Expect delays and plan accordingly.** Please follow all detours and construction signage. Be aware that the Contractor is planning on working most Saturdays to ensure the road can be opened prior to Memorial Day.

Phases 1 - 3 (S Lake Shore Drive between Shabbona Drive and Abbey Springs entrance, & Brickley Drive): Phases 1 – 3 are substantially complete. Occasional punch list items including manhole cover adjustments and maintenance work are scheduled for this spring, however no full road closures are anticipated.

Phase 4 (S Lake Shore Drive east of Abbey Springs entrance to eastern Village/project limits at Lake Geneva Yacht Club): Concrete work is now complete. Backfilling behind the curbs, utility structure adjustment and restoration work is continuing. A reminder that all traffic is required to stay off the new concrete, including driveways, for 7 days after installation. Property owners can park along the curb in the street overnight. Asphalt paving crews are scheduled to start road fine grading followed by asphalt installation the week of May 10th. **S Lake Shore Drive east of the Abbey Springs entrance to the eastern Village/project limits will be closed to through traffic and will be reopened prior to Memorial Day.** Access in and out of Abbey Springs will be from the west during this time.

The above schedule may be adjusted because of inclement weather. Note that the Village Contractor is not able to provide additional work for private property owners as part of the Village construction project. Feel free to contact the Village at (262) 275-6136 with any questions.
