

**ORDINANCE NO. 070610-01**

**FUELING REGULATIONS ORDINANCE**

The Village Board of the Village of Fontana-on-Geneva Lake, Walworth County, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

**SECTION 1.**

Section 54-49, Fueling Regulations, of the Village Municipal Code is hereby created to read as follows:

(a) No person shall fuel watercraft with gasoline by pouring gasoline from a portable can or container into the watercraft's fuel tank while being located at the Village owned lakefront or at any municipally owned pier in the Village. Watercraft with on-board gasoline fuel tanks must be removed from the water for fueling or be fueled at a commercial gasoline facility.

(b) No person shall store, or leave unattended, portable gasoline cans or gasoline containers on Village owned piers, or Village owned property.

(c) This section is adopted pursuant to the police power of the Village and is designed to prevent hazardous and dangerous conditions that are created by persons fueling their watercraft with hand-held gasoline cans, thus exposing themselves to the presence of gasoline fumes and the potential for the pollution of Geneva Lake by the spillage of gasoline into the lake.

**SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE**

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon and from its passage, approval and publication as required by law.
