General Business

Approve Minutes for August 30, 2018

Trustee McGreevy/ Kennedy 2nd made a MOTION to approve the minutes for the August 30, 2018 meeting, and the motion carried without negative vote.

Club Unique Drainage Concerns- Greg Trapani

Homeowner Greg Trapani discussed the water drainage issues that Club Unique has had during heavy rain storm events. Club Unique is looking for assistance from the Village to help control the flow of water through the association. The committee members discussed meeting the week of October 22nd at Club Unique to view the issues that they have and discuss possible solutions at the next meeting.

285 Waubun Runoff Concerns- Maureen Kaufman

Maureen Kaufman discussed her concerns with the water drainage issues at her residence. She claimed that after the two new houses on Shabbona Drive were constructed she has had water flooding problems. She is asking for assistance from the Village to help with the flooding issues. Kevin Day recommended replacing the existing drainage pipe with a larger plastic pipe and will present the cost at the next Public Works committee meeting.

Chlorine Treatment System Proposal-

Kevin Day discussed the issues that public works has with the chlorine treatment system that the Village currently uses. The chlorine pellets build up in the pipe joints causing the joints to be replaced several times per year for \$400 each. Day recommended switching to a liquid chlorine treatment but the Public Works committee asked Day to determine the cost and return on investment for using chlorine gas. Day will present the cost analysis at the next meeting.
